

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS: On December 11, 2025, the Board of Public Safety voted upon and approved the adoption of Georgia Department of Public Safety Maximum Rate Tariff No. 1 pertaining to Intrastate Rates and Charges Applying to Nonconsensual Vehicle Immobilization (“Tariff No. 1”), which Tariff took effect on January 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS: On December 17, 2025, I signed an Administrative Order providing that notice of the effective date of Tariff No. 1 and the Tariff itself be placed upon the Department’s website; and

WHEREAS: Subsequent to the adoption of Tariff No. 1, the Department became aware that certain changes to Tariff No. 1 were necessary in order to comport with the legislative intent of House Bill 551 and to clarify the signage requirements with which all companies performing vehicle immobilization in private parking areas must abide; and

WHEREAS: On February 12, 2026, the Board of Public Safety voted upon and approved the adoption of Georgia Department of Public Safety Maximum Rate Tariff No. 2 pertaining to Intrastate Rates and Charges Applying to Nonconsensual Vehicle Immobilization (“Tariff No. 2”), which Tariff takes effect on February 16, 2026; and

WHEREAS: Tariff No. 2 makes no changes to the Maximum Rates for vehicle immobilization as set out in Tariff No. 1.

Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Public Safety, it is hereby

ORDERED: That the Department of Public Safety adopt Georgia Department of Public Safety Maximum Rate Tariff No. 2 pertaining to Intrastate Rates and Charges Applying to Nonconsensual Vehicle Immobilization, to take effect February 16, 2026; it is further

ORDERED: That notice of the adoption of said tariff and the text of said tariff be placed upon the Department's website and the website of the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division's Regulations Compliance section.
