NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on **Monday, December 29, 2025, at 10:00 AM** in the first floor Training Room at the Department of Public Safety ("DPS" or "Department") Headquarters located at 959 United Ave SE, Atlanta, Georgia, a hearing will be held for members of the public and household goods carriers to comment upon proposed increases to the Department of Public Safety's current Maximum Rate Tariff for Carriers of Household Goods in Intrastate Transportation (or "Tariff"). The proposed adjustments are highlighted in red in Proposed Household Goods Maximum Rate Tariff No. 7.

None of the proposed increases exceeds 3% for either hourly or weight and distance rates and none of the proposed increases for packing materials exceeds 18%.

The expected effective date of the revised Tariff is Tuesday, January 13, 2026. A copy of the proposed revised Tariff (Maximum Rate Tariff No. 7) is attached to this Notice.

All interested persons are hereby advised of the opportunity to submit data, views, or arguments, orally or in writing, regarding the proposed revised Tariff. Oral comments will be limited to ten minutes per person. Anyone needing more than ten (10) minutes should request additional time by contacting **Lt. Dustin Jones**, PO Box 1456, Atlanta GA, 30371, in writing, or calling 404-624-7259, at least 24 hours prior to the hearing*.

The Department may, but shall not be required to, modify the effective date of the proposed revised tariff in response to comments received and modifications made to the proposed revised tariff.

Any written comments submitted and/or a recording of any public testimony given will be provided to the DPS Board of Public Safety no later than January 5, 2026. The board will vote on the proposed updated Tariff on Thursday, **January 8, 2026**. Should the Board approve the Tariff, the Tariff will take effect on Tuesday, January 13, 2026.
