MEMORANDUM FOR CONUS DRMS FIELD OPERATIONS


SUBJECT: Reutilization Accumulation Cycle Changes

Beginning immediately, screening and ordering during the Accumulation period for CONUS sites will be made available to Department of Defense (DOD) Reutilization customers only. We have implemented systemic controls which will restrict on-line screening and requisitioning during accumulation to DOD customers only. These customers are U.S. Air Force, U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, U.S. Coast Guard, the Defense Logistics Agency, Guard/Reserve units, and other DOD agencies such as Defense Mapping. The change applies to both electronic and walk-in processing. The changes do not apply to Foreign Excess Personal Property (FEPP) screening cycles.

The following DOD Special Programs will not be allowed to hold, freeze, or order during the Accumulation period (Days 1-7). These customers are eligible to screen and submit orders on days 1-14 of the DOD Formal screening period, and during the RTD 2 Day period in accordance with the Xcess Xpress rules established in 2002:

- DOD Contractors with: 'C', 'E', 'L', 'Q' DoDAACs
- Civil Air Patrol: FG3301 DoDAAC
- Foreign Military Sales (FMS) customers with: 'T' DoDAACs
- Law Enforcement Support Office
- Other 'HQ' and 'H9' DoDAACs
- Computers For Learning customers can only acquire items on Day 14 of Formal Screening period
