The qualifications for the LEL position require a significant amount of experience in law enforcement and include, but are not limited to:

- GOHS must be applicant's primary employment and any secondary employment must be approved.
- Must be P.O.S.T. certified and in good standing with P.O.S.T.;
- Minimum of five years of law enforcement experience;
- Minimum of three years of traffic enforcement experience;
- Minimum four years supervisory experience;
- Documented experience in giving lectures, training or presentations;
- Preferred training in the NHTSA Standardized Field Sobriety Testing curriculum;
- Preferred P.O.S.T. certified instructor;
- Preferred experience in monitoring grants;
- Preferred experience with GOHS grants and/or initiatives. (i.e. grant project director experience, coordination experience with Click it or Ticket or Operation Zero Tolerance, or other GOHS initiatives); and
- Preferred past experience as a Traffic Enforcement Network Coordinator or Assistant Coordinator; and
- Consideration will also be given to those candidates that are qualified as a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) with an active/valid certification.
